## Camp Hours

**Monday through Friday 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.**

Children should be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m. unless prior arrangements have been made.

## NOTE TO PARENTS:

Please remember that the **weekly tuition is due on the Friday BEFORE** the following week of attendance. If payment is not made by the preceding Friday, tuition for the following week will be \$16.00 late fee added. Two days or more is considered a full week. \$45.00 for one day.

Welcome to the J. Park Summer Karate Camp Program! We are excited to have you train with us. Communication is a vital key to success for all of us.

Here are some standard reminders and rules for a successful and happy summer. Please take the time to read each item.

1. **PROGRAM:**

- a. We have a very active program with a detailed daily schedule, including martial arts every day except Friday. We keep the kids busy with a variety of games, activities, field trips, and instruction time. Our program focuses on teaching kids core values including self-discipline, respect, and anti-bullying.

2. **UNIFORMS:**

- a. Students must have a clean J. Park or Omega MMA uniform to participate in class. Please remember: martial arts is our program. Students who do not participate in class on a regular basis will not be able to continue in our program.

3. **SCHEDULE:**

- a. Two days or more a week is considered a full week. The daily rate is \$45.00.

4. **PAYMENTS:**

- a. **ALL payments are due the Friday BEFORE the following week of attendance.**
- b. Checks are to be made out to J. Park.
- c. We ask that you put the week of your payment in the Memo line of the check to assist us in keeping an accurate record of your account.
- d. If timely payment is not received a late fee of **\$16.00** will be applied the following Monday.
- e. If you do not pay on Friday and do not pay the late fee Monday, summer camp for your child will be canceled.

5. **LOST AND FOUND:**

- a. Will be given away every Friday.

6. **WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.**

- a. The less your child brings to camp, the less they have to lose.
- b. **We do not allow** Nintendo DS, Trading Cards, PSP, MP#, IPOD, etc.

7. **BELONGINGS:**

- a. Please write your child's name on their uniform, clothes, and any other personal items that they bring to camp.

8. **REFERRAL REWARDS PROGRAM:**

- a. For each new student you refer that signs up, YOUR child will receive a \$50.00 gift card to Toys R Us.

# Special Activities



**Parks** – We will go to a park everyday for lunch and games, weather permitting. The Long Center Park, Wood Gate Park, Anderson Park, Crest Lake Park, or Philippe Park.

**Bowling** – Bowling once a week at Countryside Lanes.

**Movies** – We will go to the awesome AMC Woodlands 20 movie theater once a week or rent a movie to watch at the dojang. The children will choose movies with parent's permission.

**Chuck E. Cheese** – This occasional field trip is another one of the favorite activities of the children. Please provide additional money for games on this day.

**Raymond James Stadium** – We will take a tour of the facility and have a fun filled day at the stadium.

**Bright House Networks Stadium** – We will take a tour of the facility and watch a baseball game.

Other activities include art activities, dance parties, theme days, field days, dodge ball, obstacle course days, water days at the area parks, nature walks, and many more.

If the student attends only one day in a week there will be a \$45.00 fee. If there are any spaces available after pre-registration there will be limited late sign up for \$115.00 per week.
